



# Carbon Masters Labs

The Carbon Masters Labs (CML) are a series of speaker events which bring together the students from the University of Edinburgh's three world-leading Masters-level programmes focused on different aspects of climate change:

1. MSc in Carbon Finance
2. MSc in Carbon Management
3. LLM in Global Environment and Climate Change Law

For each event a world-leading expert from academia, legal practice, diplomacy, consultancy, government, international organisations etc is invited to come to Edinburgh and speak informally about their careers, current challenges, and emerging issues. The focus is vocational rather than strictly academic, and the aim is to provide a range of overlapping insights on climate change 'in the field'. In addition, the CMLs offer an important opportunity for students from the different programmes to meet, and to build strong networks with fellow carbon professionals of the future.

The CML events take place in an informal setting with the option of heading off for a drink afterwards. This is not an assessed or credit bearing course, but is rather an informal space for discussion and professional development with leaders in the field(s). The benefits include:

- developing esprit de corps;
- facilitating expert/student interaction;
- facilitating cross-programme student interaction;
- exposing experts to our students, with potential for future collaboration whether in the form of research partnerships, internships etc;
- exposure to and encouraging interdisciplinarity;
- enjoyment

There will be approximately 10 speakers per academic year (5 per semester). We look forward to seeing you at the CML.
